The Shopmobility Service in Kirkcaldy can be found in the Thistle Street Car Park with parking in the Esplanade Car Park opposite.


Tuesday to Saturday 10am-5pm



Shopmobility in GLENROTHES

Shopmobility at the Kingdom Centre is on the ground floor of the multi-storey Car Park next to the Rothes Halls. Entrance to the multi-storey Car Park is via Church Street.

Monday to Friday 10am-4.30pm



Shopmobility in DUNFERMLINE

Shopmobility in Dunfermline is on level one, (next to the lift area) of the Kingsgate multi-storey Car Park, accessed via James Street. Also in Unit 49, Kingsgate Centre. Current parking charges apply.

Monday to Saturday 9.30am-4.30pm
All services closed daily 1pm-1.30pm

Do you have difficulty getting around the shopping centres in Kirkcaldy, Glenrothes and Dunfermline?

Would you like to borrow a wheelchair or an electric scooter free of charge?

Would you like to have a companion to assist you while shopping?

Do you have difficulty getting about the shops because you cannot see too well?

If your answer to any of these questions is yes, then why not use Shopmobility?

What is Shopmobility?

Shopmobility is a scheme to lend manual and powered wheelchairs and scooters. A companion service for people who might require assistance while shopping is also available. This helps people who have limited mobility or visual impairment to shop and use other town centre facilities. A number of manual wheelchairs are available for long term hire which means you can take a wheelchair away. Ask for details.

Who can use it?

Shopmobility is open to anyone who feels that getting around the Kirkcaldy, Glenrothes and Dunfermline shopping centres is difficult.

You do not have to be registered as having a disability to use the service nor do you have to be a blue badge holder to park in our bays.

Do I have to book?

This is recommended.

A quick telephone call to Shopmobility ensures that equipment is available. An answering machine is available outwith office hours.

1. Equipment can also be booked through the Dial-A-Ride Scheme. Telephone (08451 55 11 88)
2. A volunteer companion can also be provided. However advance notice is necessary.

What happens on my first visit to Shopmobility?

On arrival at the centre you will be met by a member of staff, or volunteer, who will ask you for proof of identity and to complete a form for monitoring and insurance purposes. Instruction in the use of the equipment will be provided (please pre-book). When you and the staff are confident you can handle it, off you go. At the end of your visit return the equipment to the centre - it's as simple as that.
